Closing Date for entries . . . **6 pm, Wednesday, April 19, 2017**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

Post Dated or Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. **Telegraph, telephone, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted.**

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, excused, disqualified by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. **No refund of duplicate entries.**

The Duluth Kennel Club, Inc., does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Management is NOT responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. Consult judging program for time of judging.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/agents are responsible for having their dogs in the judging rings when classes are called. The Show-giving Club and the Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing services through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling/locating dogs. **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Crating Space will be available on a limited basis. The trial site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor beneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Duluth Kennel Club and the Duluth Heritage Sports Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates unless they are being judged.

Bitches in season (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete . . . American Kennel Club *Obedience Regulation*, amended to January 1, 2005. |

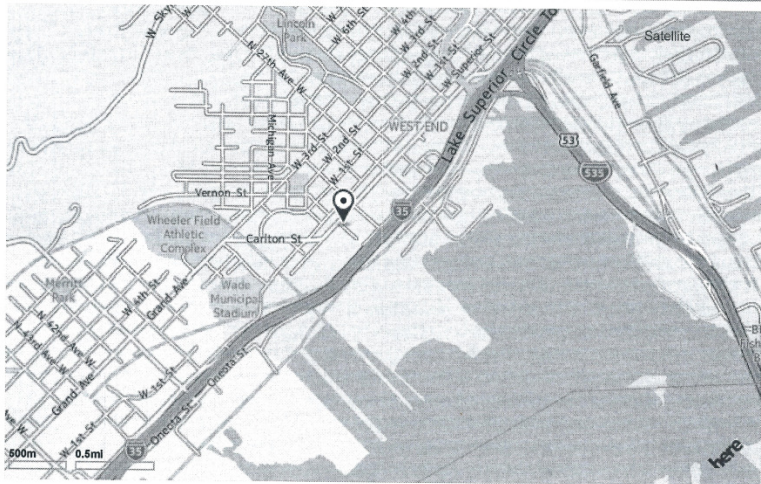
